



Registration Period: September 22, 2024 through October 20, 2024.

Registration Closure: The number of squads will be determined by the number of participants registered on or before October 20, 2024. Late registrations will be accepted only if there are vacancies in the established squads.

Registration and Fee: Signup and pay fees in the SVSC Shotgun Office which is open on Saturdays and Sundays only. Write legibly when providing your name, telephone number and email address so you will receive important information right after our first shooting date. Fall league fees are: \$56 for voting members. \$64 for non-voting members. \$80 for non-members.

Schedule: Fall league shooting will begin on Saturday, October 26, 2024 and end with a lunch and maybe a range improvement project early December. Weather delays may extend the schedule. We may also have a fun shoot with a date and games to be determined later.

Activities: The schedule will include four SVSC shooting dates and one shoot-away date for each squad, plus one makeup date and a date for a league lunch. There will be 200 total targets including 50 single trap targets (25 from the 16 yard line and 25 from the 21 yard line); 50 double trap targets; 25 regular skeet targets; 25 double skeet targets, and 50 5-Stand Targets (one game of Single, Single, Single, Double & one game of Single, Double). No more than two rounds (50 targets total) are shot on each shooting date.

First Shooting Date: Saturday October 26, 2024. <u>Please sign-in at the SVSC Shotgun Office and gather with your shooting equipment by trap field 1 by 9:00 A.M.</u> If you are late you will miss introductions and orientation.

Classifications: Shooters are designated as Class A, B, or C based on the score record. Those returning from prior leagues already have a classification based on an established average. Newcomers and beginners will be placed in Class C. The league rules establish how the average is determined. Classifications are only used for the league's Fun Shoots which are optional and cost extra.

Beginners: Beginners are welcome; this is a great way to learn shotgun sports.

Youth Participants: You must be at least 12 years of age. Any participant not yet 18 years of age must be in the company of a parent or guardian during all shooting activities.

Trophies and Awards: Sorry, there are no trophies. This is a recreational league for the purpose of learning and enjoying shotgun shooting sports.
