



2026 Summer Shotgun League.



Sign up now for the Folsom Shotgun League's 2026 summer session at the Sacramento Valley Shooting Center.

Sign Up Period: Now through June 20, 2026. Signing up after Saturday, June 20, 2026, is only possible if there is room in a squad. Squads, a schedule, and range reservations will be developed based on the applications received on and before June 20, 2026. Reserve your position early.

Application and Fees: Signup and pay target fees in the SVSC Shotgun Office on Saturdays and Sundays only. Write legibly so you will receive important information before our first shooting date. Target fees are \$84 for SVSC voting members, and \$96 for non-voting members & \$120 for non-members.

Schedule: Summer session shooting will begin on Saturday, June 20, 2026, and continue for about 11 weeks depending on weather and the number of squads.

Activities: There will be two patterns of choice. Pattern A will include 100 regular trap targets, 100 skeet targets, and 100 five-stand targets. Pattern B participants will shoot 100 double trap targets, two regular skeet rounds, and two double skeet rounds, and 100 5-stand targets. Pattern A and B squads will be separated. There will be dates for makeup and shoot-ahead shooting to accommodate absences, one optional weekend Shoot-Away or Fun Shoot date, and a range improvement project and lunch date. Pattern A shooters will shoot two rounds (50 targets) on each shooting date (mostly Saturdays). Pattern B shooters will shoot two rounds each shooting date.

First Shooting Date: Sign-in at the SVSC Shotgun Office on Saturday, June 20, 2026, then gather near Trap Field #1 by 9:30 A.M. If you are late, you will miss introductions and important information.

Classifications: **When used for optional Fun Shoots**, shooters are designated as Class A, B, or C based on the score record. The league rules outline how the established average is determined and adjusted based on scores. Classifications are used only for league fun shoots (optional activity).

Beginners: Beginners are welcome. This is a great way to learn shotgun sports.

Youth Participants: You must be at least 12 years of age. Any participant not yet 18 years of age must be in the company of a parent or guardian.

Trophies and Awards: Sorry, there are no trophies. This is a recreational league for the purpose of learning and enjoying shotgun shooting sports without competition
